He began as a flight instructor - then Okanagan, CHL - Western, doing heli-logging, firefighting, heli-skiing, arial construction. Then Frontier for 15 years. Then Flying Tankers, primarily to expand their fire-fighting work. In 1984 he received the prestigious Start of Courage for conspicuous courage during the helicopter rescue of the survivors of a plane crash near Chilliwack BC. Today he runs his own successful independent safety consulting service primarily for the BC and Alberta governments. He has roughly 11,000 hours, now.
